2. What do you think it was, about Nabal's response, that was so offensive to David?

3. Check out **Psalm 2:1-6...** How might the dynamics described in this Psalm shed some light on the ultimate "offense" of Nabal's response toward David?

4.	Nabal's ultimate spiritual condition notwithstanding, What does David's response to Nabal reveal about his own heart?
5.	God intervenes through Abigail Who are the people who benefit from Abigail's "coolheadedness", and how do they benefit? (HINT: There are quite a few)
6.	How do you feel about the outcome for Nabal in contrast to the outcome for David, vis-a-viz, fairness, justice, etc.?
7.	How might Romans 3:21-26 provide some perspective to us regarding God's dealings with David, and with us?
